

RECYCLING & YARD WASTE COLLECTION FOR THE ARDENS

Waste Management is collecting recyclables and yard waste on Thursday.
 Place recyclables and yard waste out the night before collection.
 Trash collection will remain on Friday. Holidays may make both a day late.

RECYCLABLES

Use your 65-gallon blue can. All items must be clean and dry with less than 5% food debris.

Paper <i>Must be clean and dry.</i>	Newspapers Printer and copier paper Mail Phone books Catalogs Magazines All other office paper	Wax paper Tissues Paper towels
Cardboard and Paperboard <i>Must be clean and dry</i>	Corrugated cardboard Cereal boxes	Pizza boxes and other cardboard that has been in contact with food Microwave trays
Glass <i>Remove metal caps and rings.</i>	Brown, clear or green glass food and beverage containers	Mirrors Window & auto glass Light bulbs Ceramics Porcelain Glass cookware & bakeware
Metal <i>Must be clean and dry.</i>	Aluminum food and beverage containers Ferrous (iron or tin) cans	Cooking pots & other household items Clothes hangers
Plastic <i>All containers must be clean and empty with caps removed. Narrow neck or screw-top containers only.</i>	Plastic bags PET plastic containers with symbol #1 HOPE natural plastic containers with symbol #2, such as milk & water bottles HOPE pigmented plastic containers with symbol #2, such as detergent & shampoo bottles Plastics with the symbols #3, #4, #5, #6, #7, narrow and screw top containers only	Un-numbered plastics Microwave trays Yogurt containers and other wide-mouth plastic containers

YARD WASTE

Place in plastic bags or bundle with string.
 Grass clippings, leaves and other yard waste should be in plastic bags.
 Small limbs cut to no more than 4-foot lengths and tied into a collectable bundle.
